Writes about central and eastern Europe. He was twice a U.S. Fulbright senior lecturer, at Comenius University in Bratislava, Slovakia and at the University of Malta in Valletta, Malta. Before moving to Prague, Giarelli taught in Portland State University's English department from 1996-2006 and helped to start its graduate writing program. He was also the founding editor of the U.S. regional magazine Edging West and before that a journalism professor at Utah State University and New York University. Giarelli was a contributing editor for the international news digest World Press Review from 1980-2000. He has written for various print and online media on press issues, European culture and politics, and the American West. He has a B.A. from Yale University and a Ph.D. from the State University of New York at Buffalo. His novel *The Talking Statues* was published by danzig&unfried (Vienna) in 2021. His forthcoming book of reportage, *Millennial Mitteleuropa*, will be published by danzig&unfried in 2024.
